

**THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF
NORTHEASTERN MANITOULIN AND THE ISLANDS**

BY-LAW NO. 2001-29

**BEING A BY-LAW TO REGULATE, PROHIBIT OR RESTRICT
THE SUPPLY OF WATER WITHIN THE TOWN OF
NORTHEASTERN MANITOULIN AND THE ISLANDS**

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Northeastern Manitoulin and the Islands deems it desirable to enact a by-law respecting the time, extent and nature of the supply of water to the residents of the Town of Northeastern Manitoulin and the Islands.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Northeastern Manitoulin and the Islands **ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. **DEFINITIONS**

The following words and phrases, when used in the by-law for the purposes of this by-law, shall have the meanings respectively ascribed to them in this section:

- a) Municipal Property – includes all property owned, leased or managed by the Town of Northeastern Manitoulin and the Islands;
 - b) Institutions – means any properties funded by means of a grant from the Government of Canada, the Province of Ontario or the Town of Northeastern Manitoulin and the Islands.
2. No person shall use water from any municipal waterworks for lawn and garden watering in the Town of Northeastern Manitoulin and the Islands during the months of June, July and August, except as follows:
- a) The owner or occupant of a property bearing an even street number, may use municipal water for lawn and garden watering only on even numbered days of the month;
 - b) The owner or occupant of a property bearing an odd street number, may use municipal water for lawn and garden watering only on odd numbered days of the month.
3. The consumption of water by users of the municipal water supply, except by those listed in clause 4 following, for the purpose as laid out in clause 2 above, shall be limited to the period of 7:00 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. to 9:00 p.m. on the days applicable to the property.
4. The consumption of water by the owners or occupants of the following properties, for the purposes as laid out in clause 2 above, shall be limited to the period of 7:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. on the days applicable to the property:
- a) schools
 - b) municipal property
 - c) institutions
5. Any person who contravenes any provision of this By-law is guilty of an offence and upon conviction is liable to a fine of not less than ONE HUNDRED DOLLARS (\$100.) and not more than ONE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$1,000.).

6. THAT By-law No. 1703 of the former Corporation of the Town of Little Current be and is hereby repealed.
7. THAT this By-law will be short-titled, "**Lawn and Garden Watering**".
8. THAT this By-law shall come into force and take effect immediately upon the passing thereof by the Council of the Town of Northeastern Manitoulin and the Islands.
