WHEREAS Children's Aid Societies across Ontario are experiencing significant financial pressures, with the majority of agencies running deficits in the millions;

WHEREAS the Financial Accountability Office has indicated funding for child protection has fallen behind inflation, with the sector missing \$70 million compared to previous funding levels;

WHEREAS the current funding model implemented in 2013 has limitations that affect the safety and well-being of children, particularly in northern and remote communities; WHEREAS the Ministry of Children, Community and Social Services's pending on Child Protection Services is projected to grow at only 0.7% annually from 2023-24 to 2028-29, well below inflation;

WHEREAS the child welfare redesign strategy requires enhanced community-based prevention services and improved quality of care, which cannot be achieved without adequate funding.

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of Northeastern Manitoulin and the Islands supports the Federation of Northern Ontario Municipalities (FONOM), and calls on the Government of Ontario to immediately address the funding shortfall in child welfare by providing emergency stabilization funding to Children's Aid Societies;

Requests that the Ministry of Children, Community and Social Services undertake **a Province wide service review**, including the funding model. During the review, FONOM asks that the following be included in the review.

- Adequately addresses the unique challenges of northern and remote communities;
- Account created for higher operational costs in geographically dispersed regions;
- Provide sustainable funding for prevention services;
- Urges the Province to implement multi-year funding commitments that allow for proper planning and service delivery;
- Advocates for the development of a specific Northern Strategy for child welfare that recognizes the unique needs and challenges of Northern communities.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this resolution be forwarded to: The Honorable Michael Parsa, Minister of Children, Community and Social Services, the Ontario Association of Children's Aid Societies, Association of Native Child and Family Services Agencies of Ontario, All municipalities within FONOM's jurisdiction, the Association of Municipalities of Ontario (AMO), Rural Ontario Municipal Association (ROMA), and the leaders of the Opposition Parties.

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF NORTHEASTERN MANITOULIN AND THE ISLANDS BY-LAW NO. 2025-04

BEING A BY-LAW FOR THE BORROWING FROM TD CANADA TRUST UNTIL THE TAXES ARE COLLECTED

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Northeastern Manitoulin and the Islands deems it necessary to borrow the sum of \$2,000,000 dollars to meet, until the taxes are collected, the current expenditures of the Corporation for the year;

AND WHEREAS the amount of the estimated revenues of the Corporation as set out in the estimates adopted for the prior year is \$7,619,780 dollars;

AND WHEREAS the amount to be borrowed under this by-law and the amounts of borrowings that have not been repaid does not in the aggregate exceed 50% of the estimated revenues of the Corporation as set out above.

NOW BE IT THEREFORE enacted by the said Council as follows:

Dated this _____ day of _____, 2025.

- 1) The Mayor and the CAO of the Corporation are hereby authorized on behalf of the Corporation to borrow from time to time, by way of promissory note from TD Canada Trust, a sum or sums not exceeding in the aggregate \$2,000,000 dollars to meet, until taxes are collected, the current expenditures of the Corporation of the year, including the amounts required for the purposes mentioned in s. 407 of the Municipal Act, 2001and to give, on behalf of the Corporation, to the Bank a promissory note or notes, sealed with the corporate seal and signed by them for the moneys so borrowed, and such other documentation as may be requested by the Bank therefore, with interest at a rate not exceeding the floating annual rate of interest established from time to time by TD Canada Trust as the base rate it will use to determine rates of interest on Canadian Dollar loans to Municipalities in Canada and designated as Municipal Prime Rate, which may be paid in advance or otherwise.
- 2) All sums borrowed from the said Bank, for any or all of the purposes mentioned in the said Section 407 shall, with interest thereon, be a charge upon the whole of the revenues of the Corporation for the current year and for all preceding years, as and when such revenues are received.
- 3) The Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to apply in payment of all sums borrowed pursuant to the authority of this by-law, as well as all the other sums borrowed in this year and any previous years, from the said Bank for any or all of the purposes mentioned in the said Section 407 together with interest thereon, all of the moneys hereafter collected or received on account or realized in respect of the taxes levied for the current year and preceding years and all of the moneys collected or received from any other source, which may lawfully be applied for such purpose.

BY-LAW NO. 2025- 65

BEING A BY-LAW TO PROVIDE FOR AN INTERIM TAX LEVY AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE PAYMENT OF TAXES AND TO PROVIDE FOR PENALTY AND INTEREST OF 1-1/4 PERCENT PER MONTH

WHEREAS the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c.25, s.317, provides that a local municipality, before the adoption of the estimates, for the year under section 290, may pass a by-law levying amounts on the assessment of property in the local municipality rateable for local municipality purposes;

WHEREAS the amount levied on a property shall not exceed 50 percent of the total amount of taxes for municipal and school purposes levied on the property for the previous year, pursuant to Section 317(3) of the said Act;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Northeastern Manitoulin and the Islands ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. THAT interim taxes be hereby imposed and levied on the whole of the assessment for real property for all assessment classes such that the amount levied shall not exceed 50 percent of the total amount of taxes for municipal and school purposes levied on the property for the 2024 taxation year.
- 2. THAT the said interim tax levy shall become due and payable in two (2) installments as follows:
 - 50 percent of the interim levy shall become due and payable on the 28th day of February, 2025 and
 - the balance of the interim levy shall become due and payable on the 28th day of April, 2025 and
 - non-payment of the amount on the dates stated in accordance with this section shall constitute default.
- 3. THAT on all taxes of the interim levy which are in default on the respective days of demand, a penalty of 1-1/4 percent shall be added and thereafter a penalty of 1-1/4 percent per month will be added on the first day of each and every month the default continues, until December 31st, 2025.
- 4. THAT on all taxes of the interim tax levy in default on January 1st, 2025, interest will be added at the rate of 1-1/4 percent per month for each month or fraction thereof of default.
- 5. THAT on all other taxes in default on January 1st, 2025, interest shall be added at the rate of 1-1/4 percent per month or fraction thereof, and all by-laws and parts of by-laws inconsistent with this policy are hereby rescinded.
- 6. THAT penalties and interest added on all taxes of the interim tax levy in default shall become due and payable and shall be collected forthwith as if the same had originally been imposed and formed part of such unpaid interim tax levy.
- 7. THAT the collector may mail or cause the same to be mailed to the residence or place of business of such person indicated on the last revised assessment roll, a written or printed notice specifying the amount of taxes payable.
- 8. THAT taxes are payable at the Municipal Office of the Town of Northeastern Manitoulin and the Islands, Little Current, Ontario.

Resolution for Consideration - Expanding EPR to the ICI sector

Good morning

Please share this email with your Mayor, Council and Senior Management

The BlueBox and recycling are essential to many of your citizens. In Northeastern Ontario, municipalities will transition to Full Extended Producer Responsibility (EPR) for the household BlueBox program over the next few years. EPR will be important for the Province of Ontario, as producers/stewarts will soon create a sustainable circulatory economy for the paper, packaging and products a household recycles.

Producers/Stewarts are not responsible for products purchased within the Industrial, Commercial, and Institutional (ICI) sectors. Products recycled at home are disposed of by an ICI-funded program or landfilled.

All municipalities are concerned with the lifespan of landfills, and FONOM believes it is important that the Province and the Producers/Stewarts start discussing the transition to a producer-funded EPR system for the recyclables generated by the ICI Sector.

We ask your council to consider supporting the draft resolution below.

I am happy to answer any questions you may have.

WHEREAS under Ontario Regulation 391/21: Blue Box, producers are fully accountable and financially responsible for their products and packaging once they reach their end of life and are disposed of, for 'eligible' sources only;

AND WHEREAS 'ineligible' sources which producers are not responsible for including businesses, places of worship, daycares, campgrounds, public-facing and internal areas of municipal-owned buildings and not-for-profit organizations, such as shelters and food banks;

AND WHEREAS should a municipality continue to provide services to the 'ineligible' sources, the municipality will be required to oversee the collection, transportation, and processing of the recycling, assuming 100% of the costs;

AND WHEREAS these costs will further burden the municipalities' finances and potentially take resources away from vital infrastructure projects;

THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Council of the	hereby request that the
province amend Ontario Regulation 391/21: Blue Box so that produ	icers are responsible for
the end-of-life management of recycling products from all sources	

AND FURTHER THAT this resolution be forwarded to the Honourable Andrea Khanjin, Minister of the Environment, Conservation and Parks, Your Local MPP, AMO, ROMA and FONOM

Dear Mayor and Council, Northeastern Manitoulin and the Islands:

I submit the following for consideration at the earliest possible council meeting.

Please pass a motion declaring NEMI does not support the movement of radioactive materials from Nipissing First Nation to the Agnew Lake Tailings Management Area. The safety of our water could be directly threatened.

The material excavated from these sites is temporarily being stored on a vacant lot in the Bineshii Business Park that has been lined with geotextile matting to safely contain it.

The MTO is working to identify an alternative disposal site in case approvals for the ALTMA site are further delayed or denied.

Until approval to haul the material to the Agnew Lake Tailings Management Area or another approved disposal site is in place, NFN has paused any further excavation and storage of the contaminated material on NFN lands.

There is still no acknowledgement that radioactive uranium tailings are part of the waste to be transferred.

I believe there will be discussion at ROMA (Rural Ontario Municipal Association) next week between the affected municipalities and the MTO. Hopefully saner heads will prevail, stopping this unnecessary make work project from taking place. The waste should remain encapsulated where it is, with reasonable land and cash settlements being offered as compensation to Nipissing First Nation.

The letter below was published in the Manitoulin Expositor.

An emergency meeting was conducted Wednesday, October 2, 2024 by the Township of Nairn and Hyman (TNH) and the Township of Baldwin (TB) in regards to a plan to deliver radioactive waste from Nipissing First Nation (NFN) to the Agnew Lake Tailings Management Area (ALTMA) located north of Webbwood, Espanola, and Nairn. More than 40 members of the public attended.

This meeting followed a town hall conducted on September 11, 2024. Despite a request for information and a halt to proceedings following this gathering by THN and TB, construction carried on around ALTMA.

Attendees at the town hall were misinformed that the fill arriving from NFN was "NORM" (Normal Occurring Radioactive Material) when in fact the fill was radioactive uranium and niobium, heavy metals, and chemicals represented as tailings, of significantly higher risk to human health and the environment.

As a fellow attendee pointed out, "a professional engineer with a BSc. in chemistry was present and outlined that the proposed waste was in fact tailings, with uranium, niobium (neither of which are naturally occurring), heavy metals and

possibly acid (as in "acid rain"). None of the Ministries are responding to requests for more information. Nor is it known whether the "tailings" to be trucked from NFN have been tested for uranium, and if they have been tested, what the results are. The Beaucage Mine/Mill was the first of its kind in North America (an experimental mine with experimental processes) and we learned at the most recent meeting that the mine had to be shut down after 9 months - this left contaminated ore which hadn't been completely treated to be sent directly to the "tailings" (now the subject of this current proposal). They want to ship these tailings to the former Agnew Mine site."

The Beaucage experiment was a failure.

The Canadian Nuclear Safety Commission (CNSC) has committed to providing the townships with recent inspection reports from ALTMA.

In an email dated October 2, 2024, CNSC has stated: "...we have not yet accepted Mine's plans for movement of Niobium material to the ALTMA site, we have some remaining questions relating to management of water that might come into contact with Beaucage tailings after they are emplaced at ALTMA but before they are covered. Because of that, we can't say anything on timeframe for material movement. We are neither trying to push this project forward, nor trying to slow it up – but we won't allow it to progress until we are satisfied that the work will be safe for workers and the environment."

Water from the Lake Agnew area will eventually flow into the North Channel.

Citizens around ALTMA must be provided full disclosure of information from the Ministry of Natural Resources (MNR), the Ministry of Transportation (MTO), and CNSC relating to the proposed shipment of radioactive materials from NFN. Full disclosure would include monitoring results of air, water, and soil from ALTMA and NFN. Only then can an informed decision be made.

A motion was carried to demand no shipments of radioactive material from NPN until further information is provided. TNH and TB are to be notified in advance of any shipments to ALTMA (presently, there is no duty to inform from MNR, MTO, & CNSC). Also, any fill to be used at ALTMA must be clean fill.

A most remarkable event occurred during the emergency meeting. A councilor requested a break in proceedings to speak with the public regarding new CNSC information that had just been presented. All council members and staff present made a point of speaking to all citizens present, canvassing their concerns. Following the meeting, council and staff once again made themselves available. Other municipalities would do well to follow this example.

I would like to take the opportunity to acknowledge the unfortunate situation faced by Nipissing First Nation. I appreciate they don't want this radioactive material either. Other solutions must be considered.
