## When Considering Approval, we should consider:

## A. Consents

A consent shall only be considered where a plan of subdivision is deemed to be unnecessary, where the application conforms with the policies of this Plan, is consistent with the Provincial Policy Statement, and the consent will generally not result in the creation of more than five new lots on a lot that existed prior to the date of adoption of this Plan, and it does not necessitate the creation of a new municipal road, or the extension of municipal services.

Council shall provide input on municipal conditions of approval for consents.

The proposed lot and retained lot shall have frontage and access on to an opened and maintained public road, or have private road or water access in compliance with the policies of this Plan.

MTO's policy is to allow only one highway entrance for each lot of record fronting onto a provincial highway. AMTO will not allow backlots to create a second entrance on the highway. MTO will not support a consent to separate a home-based business from a residential use which would result in separate entrances for the business and residential parcels.

Lots will not be created which would create a traffic hazard due to limited sight lines on curves or grades.

The lot area and frontage of both the lot to be retained and the lot to be severed will be adequate for existing and proposed uses and will allow for the development of a use which is compatible with adjacent uses by providing for sufficient setbacks from neighbouring uses and, where required, the provision of appropriate buffering.

The proposed lot(s) will not restrict the development of other parcels of land, particularly the provision of access to allow the development of remnant parcels in the interior of a block of land.

The proposed development will be serviced in accordance with the policies of Section E.

The parkland dedication policies of Section F.4.3 will apply.

### Remarks to approval considerations.

This application does not constitute a need for a subdivision

The proposed lot severance has direct access to Hwy 6, a year round road.

Both the retained and severed lots have more than adequate frontage and size as per our zoning by-laws.

As per the attached diagram the proposed severance will not restrict any development to surrounding properties.

All services to this area will be private services.

No Park land dedication will be required.




Figure 1: Detailed Sketch of Lot 11, Concession 12, and proposed consent

I am pleased to advise that FedNor is prepared to provide support of up to \$125,165 towards the revitalization of Little Current's Low Island Park recreation facilities.

This Contribution Agreement is open for acceptance for 60 days from the date that appears on its face after which time it will become null and void. The date of acceptance shall be the date the duplicate copy of this Agreement, unconditionally accepted and duly executed by the Recipient, is received by my office.



## 2.0 The Project

- 2.1 The Recipient shall ensure that the Project described in Annex 1 (the "Project") commences on or before January 1, 2022 (the "Commencement Date") and is completed on or before November 30, 2022 (the "Completion Date").
- 2.2 The Recipient shall not alter the scope, timing or location of the Project without the prior written consent of the Agency.

## 3.0 The Contribution

- 3.1 The Agency will make a Contribution (the "Contribution") to the Recipient in respect of the Project in an amount not exceeding the lesser of:
  - a) 75% of the incurred Eligible & Supported Costs of \$166,888 of the Project outlined in Annex 1, and
  - b) \$125,165.
- 3.2 The Agency shall not normally contribute to any Eligible and Supported Costs incurred prior to April 19, 2021 or later than the Completion Date.
  - The Agency shall not make any payment of the Contribution in respect of costs for which the Recipient has entered into a legal commitment prior to the Application Received Date.
- 3.3 Notwithstanding 3.2 the Agency may, at its sole discretion, limit to 10% of the Contribution the amount paid towards Eligible and Supported Costs incurred by the Recipient between the date that the completed and signed Application was received and the Commencement Date.
- 3.4 The Recipient shall use the Contribution solely and exclusively to support the Eligible and Supported Costs of the Project as detailed in Annexes 1 and 2 and shall carry out the Project in a diligent and professional manner.
- 3.5 The Recipient shall be responsible for all costs of the Project, including cost overruns, if any.
